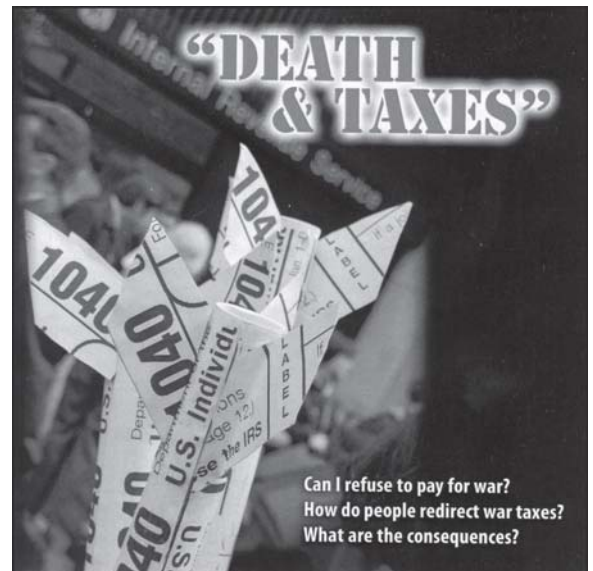


Julia Butterfly Hill shares about her work as part of the war-tax resistance movement and how this is a vital part of her activism and life philosophy.
