

Update!

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Taxpayers will be eligible for a refund for the tax paid on long distance service in the last 3 years. It appears the refund will be offered with the tax forms sent in January 2007 to file for 2006 taxes.

The IRS lost more than 7 federal district court cases brought by large corporations against the way the tax was applied to flat rate service. Finally, in May 2006, the IRS conceded defeat and announced an end to the tax on long distance service.

A repeal of the federal excise tax on **local service** must be decided by Congress. The bill, S. 1321, may yet receive approval in 2006. If the bill passes, the tax will expire 90 days after the vote.
